I am a UX/UI Designer from Belfast, Northern Ireland. In 2015 I completed a four-year course at the University of Ulster in Interactive Multimedia Design.

Towards the end of my time at Citi a moved into their marketing sector to create internal emails, pop-ups and print documents for use throughout the world.

My first official step into the design and web development industry was with Sport Northern Ireland as part of my placement year at university.
